## **Events**

**During the 2025 season, the Château d'Ainay-le-Vieil is participating in the 6th edition of the Nouvelles Renaissances, which will be celebrated under the theme of "celebration" in the Centre-Val de Loire region.**

The Centre-Val de Loire will be celebrating a triple anniversary: the 25th anniversary of the Loire Valley's inscription on the UNESCO World Heritage List, the 20th anniversary of the Loire à Vélo cycling route, which launched the cycling tourism dynamic in the region, and the 15th anniversary of the inscription of the gastronomic meal of the French on the UNESCO list. This recognition of our French art de vivre, the time shared with family and friends around a table or on a stroll, is a constant source of inspiration for the Château d'Ainay-le-Vieil. We indeed welcome a large number of cycling visitors each year who pass along the Canal de Berry and stop by the château.

The Château d'Ainay-le-Vieil is also a gastronomic stop, as Maria Rodriguez has been running the restaurant La Volière for the past three years. She offers fine dining that combines local cuisine with South American flavors, being Venezuelan herself.

**These anniversaries will inspire us to offer our visitors new experiences related to French history, culture, art, garden art, slow tourism, and gastronomy. Many discoveries await throughout the 2025 season.**




## Saturday, May 10, and Sunday, May 11


